You will have a combination of theory and practical training; this will include:

- Dedicated workshops covering cutting, colouring, perming and long hair.
- Your salon will help with your training on a daily basis, and offer styling sessions for you to practice your skills.
- The opportunity to work on 'real clients' during the BL Hairdressing Training Centre salon training days.

Becoming a hairdresser with BL Hairdressing Training is a rewarding experience, and we expect very high standards of attendance, dedication and time keeping.

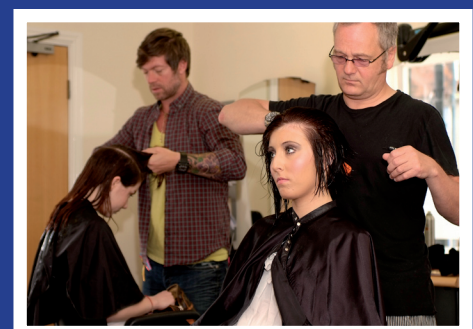
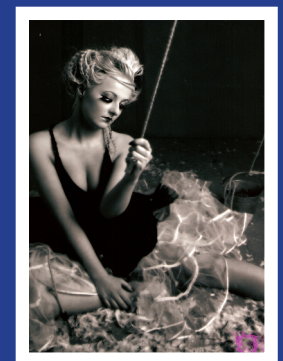
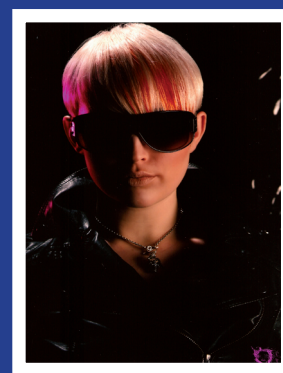
